

## Montessori At The Woods



The Woods Academy offers a Montessori program that is designed to meet the needs and interests of the three to six year old child. The multi-age classrooms are prepared environments where learning is intrinsically motivating and joyful. There are opportunities to lead, to teach, to interact and to learn by

observing others. Shelves housing materials are located at child-level so that children may pursue their own interests at their own pace under the guidance of our dedicated and well-trained teachers and staff.

### A Montessori Day

Group times for singing, stories, poetry, sharing and outdoor play augment the individual and small group activities in the classroom. All students participate in weekly library story time, music, and physical education. In addition, our Luncher Program for five/six year olds includes art, French or Spanish, music, guidance and computers. Four year olds have the option of participating in a four day a week full day program when they are ready for an extended day of Montessori, Hands On Science and cooking.



### The Montessori Curriculum

The four general areas of a Montessori classroom—Practical Life, Sensorial, Math and Language—interact to provide each child with a rich and rewarding preschool experience. All Montessori activities meet the needs and rapid pace of learning in young children as they create new knowledge, reinforce lessons already encountered, and explore the world around them.
